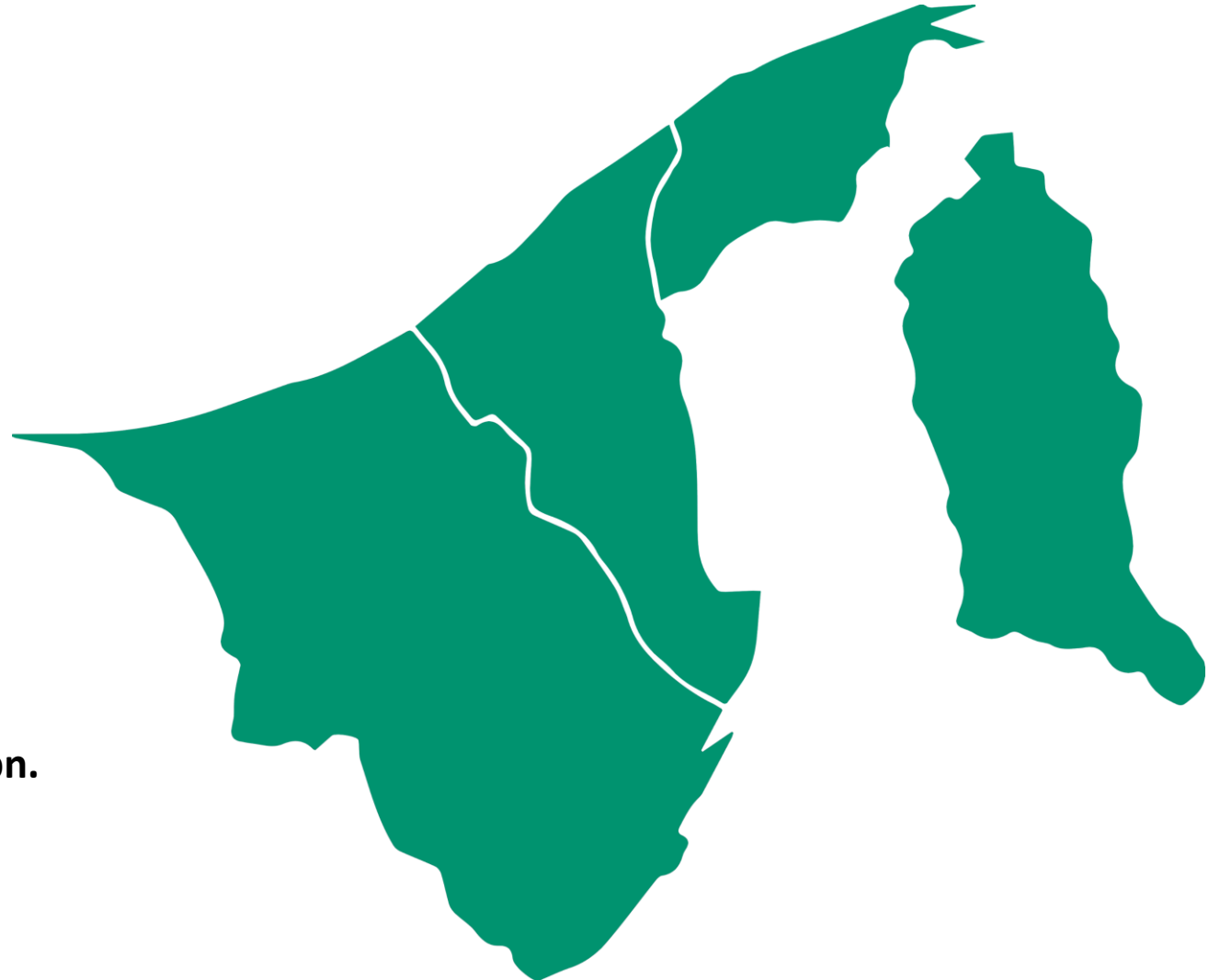

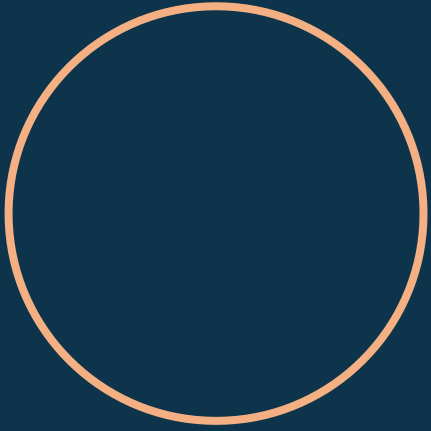
Provide equal and equitable access to quality education.

- Means-tested (under research)

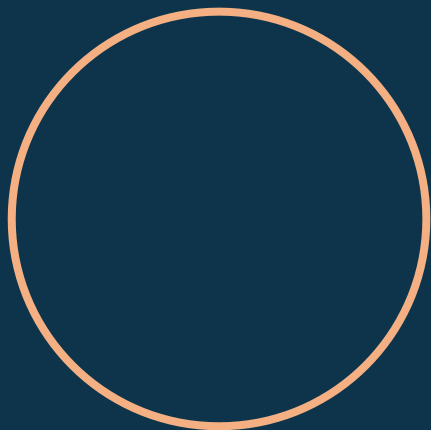

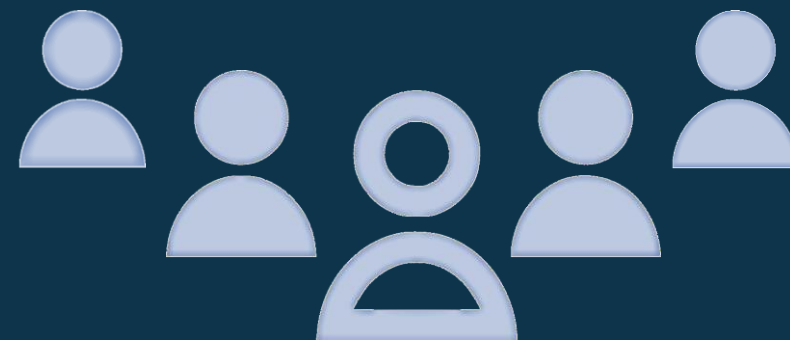

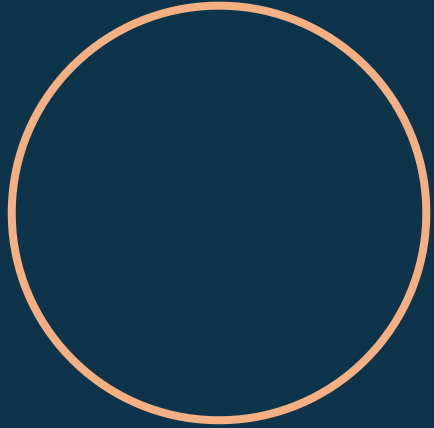
