 - 1989 Establishment of the first public university – The University of Cyprus

 - 50 Institutions of Tertiary Education






Cyprus Government Strategic Goal "Access to Higher Education for All"

- Tuition fees
 - Free for Cypriot/EU Students in Public Universities' Undergraduate Programmes
- Enrollment criteria
 - Pancyprian (National) Exams for entry at the Public Universities' Undergraduate Programmes (for all secondary education graduates)
- Financial aid
 - Student grants/allowances
 - scholarship schemes
- Measures for students with special needs (e.g., EPFIME project)

EPFIME Project

- Establishing a thought-out Policy Framework for Inclusive Mobility across Europe
- 2-year project
- Co-funded by Erasmus+ KA3 Support to Policy reform 2018-2020
- Examining needs and expectations on inclusive mobility of students with disabilities
- Creating of a platform for Countries and Higher Education Institutions to provide relative information



Financial Aid

State's Students Welfare Service

Annual application based on socioeconomic criteria

- Student Grant
- Student Allowances

Approximately 50 million euros / 22 000 students/families / per year

State's Scholarship Foundation of Cyprus

Annual application based on socioeconomic criteria and academic criteria

approximately 8 million euros / 1 200 students/families / per year

State's Independent Agency for Social Support

Annual application based on socioeconomic criteria

Financial aid is provided to students that are facing a termination of their studies due to their economic status
